TAKE THESE STEPS TO BECOME AN ACCREDITATION REVIEWER

1. Attend an Accreditation Institute and reviewer training.
2. Submit a cover letter and resume that highlight interest and background in assessment and evaluation.
3. Submit three letters of reference/support, one from a NADE chapter leader and two from developmental education professionals.
4. Send the above items to the Review Operations Coordinator.
